- · Sustained Growth Led by NA, Europe, China
  - N. America: KRW 807.2 bn (YoY +24.1%)
  - Europe: KRW 674.3 bn (YoY + 12.9%)
  - China: KRW 171.2 bn (YoY + 12.8%)



#### Operating Profit: KRW 321.7 bn

- ≥18" Product Mix Reached 43%
  - Strengthened portfolio with premium launches including the ECSTA Sport series

### 2Q 2025 Financial Results



- 2Q sales reached KRW 1,221.3 billion (YoY +7.9%), driven by continued growth in key accounts and volume
- Strong OP (KRW 175.2 bn) and OPM (14.3%): powered by value-focused sales growth in premium and large-diameter products
- **⊘** OE (YoY + 23.5%) and RE (YoY + 3.6%) growth: driven by expanded supply for new models and specs from OEMs

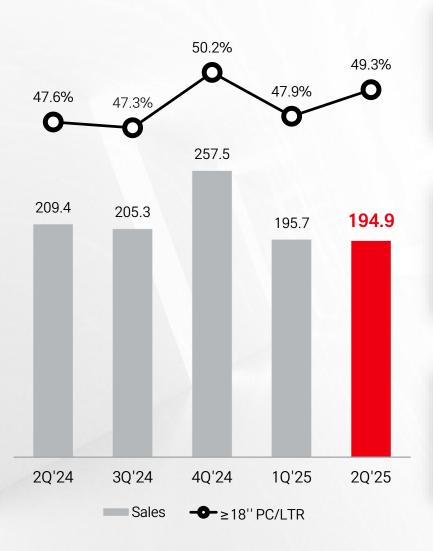

#### Market

- New car sales up on consumption tax cuts and rising EV/hybrid demand
  - 1H new car sales: 822,000 units (YoY +3.1%, vs. 800,000 units in 1H '24)
  - Tire market: PC -2.2%, LT -4.0%, TB +14.3% (Jan-May, cumulative)

#### OE

 EV recovery lags (Kia EV6, Hyundai Kona EV); hybrid & large ICE demand picking up

- Improved high-margin product mix through retail channel expansion
- Margin-focused operations via pricing structure and logistics infrastructure enhancements

#### North America (KRW bn)



#### Market

- Pre-hike demand boosted by tariff policy and stronger new car sales
- 1H new car sales: 9.344 mn units (YoY +3.6%, vs. 9.02 mn in 1H '24)
- Tire market: OE-5%, RE +2% (1H)

#### OE

- YoY volume growth and M/S gains; slight QoQ sales increase from partial C/M production shifts
- Profitability improved through expanded sourcing to NA Big 3
  - Centered on large sedans, SUVs, and strategic models (EV/Performance)

- Volume growth and margin gains through new accounts & project-based sales
- Expanded high-value offering through new product launches

#### **Europe** (KRW bn)



#### Market

- © Growth led by low-priced EVs; ICE vehicle sales declining
- 1H new car sales: 8.891 mn units (YoY -2.8%, vs. 9.15 mn in 1H '24)
- Tire market: OE -8%, RE +5% (1H)

#### OE

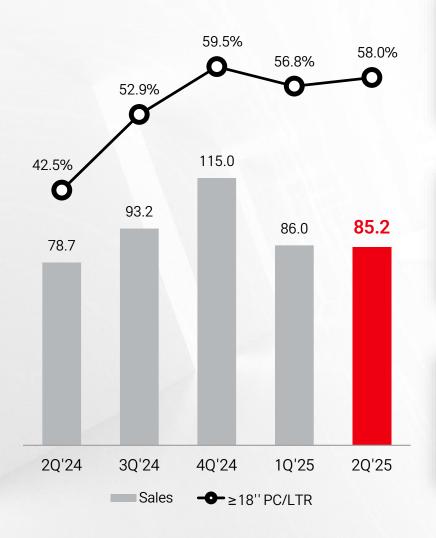
- Increased volume and model coverage at overseas C/Ms (Mercedes-Benz, VW, SEAT, SKODA, etc)
- New project supply launched (e.g., SKODA Enyaq, Elroq)

- Stable sales base via new retail contracts and partner marketing
- Seasonal order growth and pricing improvements to boost margins

#### Market

• New car sales up on domestic and EU export growth

 1H new car sales: 12.67 mn units (YoY +7.5%, vs. 11.79 mn in 1H '24)

Tire market: OE + 10%, RE 0% (1H)

#### OE

- Growth led by expanded supply to Chinese C/Ms (Chery, SAIC, Geely)
- High-margin HVP supply increasing profit contribution

- Inventory reduction and increased customer inflow driven by dealer marketing support
- Brand visibility enhanced through sales network expansion

- 2024 Sales: KRW 4.5 tn → 2025 Sales Target: KRW 5.0 tn
- Cumulative 2Q sales: KRW 2,427.5 bn → achieved 48.6% of 2025 target

#### **⊘** Target Sales Ratio of ≥18" Products in PCLT: 46%

- ≥18" sales mix in PCLT: 38.1% in '23 → 41.8% in '24 → target 46% in '25
- 2Q sales mix of large-diameter (≥18") products: 43.4%
- Enhanced premium large-diameter product portfolio with ECSTA Sport series, SOLUS Advance

#### **⊗** EV Tire Supply Target Ratio: 26%

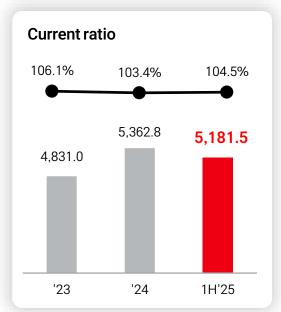

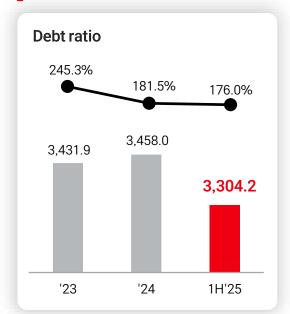

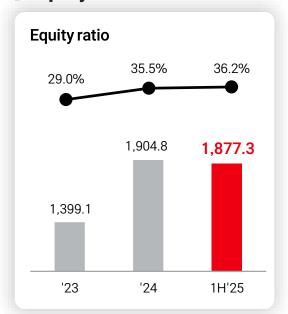




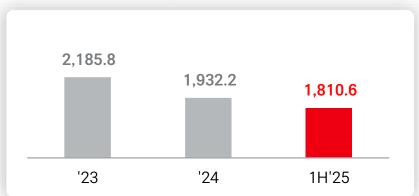
#### Liabilities (KRW bn)



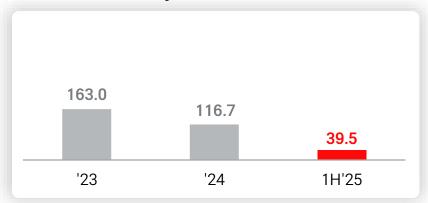
#### **Equity** (KRW bn)

#### Raw Materials Trends

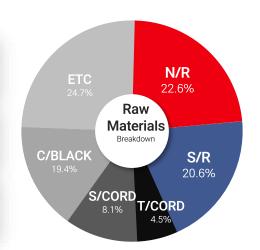
Natural Rubber

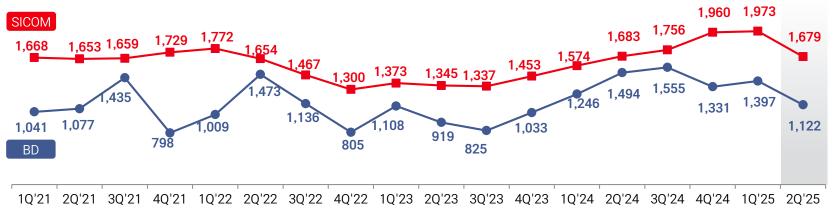
Synthetic Rubber

BD price at \$1,122/ton (2Q): weak volume on tariff uncertainty, prices flat on rising supply

Price drop limited by supply concerns amid U.S.-China tariff and prolonged Iran sanctions; further downside expected on OPEC output hike and slowing global demand

#### Global SCM Logistics and Business Freight Costs

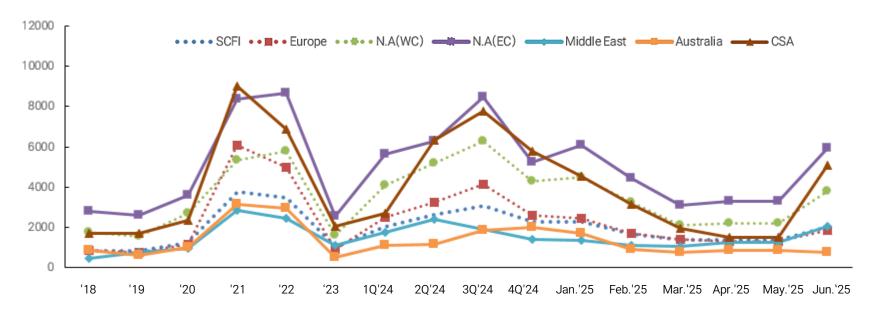
Global/Domestic Logistics Market

- Stabilization underway with tariff talks nearing conclusion, but short-term demand shocks may trigger spikes

- 2Q '25 freight savings from rate adjustments and cost-reduction efforts
- 2H savings likely to narrow due to lower freight costs for new Europe/GEM contracts
